Introducing the 75 Squadron RAF/RNZAF Association Ladies Scarf.

The 75 Squadron Association Scarf has been designed to show all eight aircraft types the Squadrons flew from 1938 until it's premature disbandment in December 2001.

The RAF service aircraft of the Wellington, Stirling, Lancaster and Lincoln feature at one end, representing the pre-war and WW2 operations from RAF Bases Harwell, Marham, Feltwell, Stradishall, Mildenhall, New Market Heath, Mepal and Spilsby.

At the other end, the RNZAF service aircraft of the Mosquito, Vampire, Canberra and Skyhawk are featured representing the post war aircraft operated from RNZAF Ohakea and Tengah airbase in Singapore. The Squadron Badge was designed in 1943, and the squadron No. and Badge was given to the RNZAF in 1946 to honour the war time work and NZ commitment.

There were three Squadron badges, RAF, RNZAF (1946-53) and RNZAF (1953-2001). Also included is the badge of the RAF Bomber Command of WW2.

The aircraft featured are chosen for some special reasons.....

Wellington 1C, AA-R: L7817. The aircraft James Allen Ward saved and was awarded the VC.

Stirling III, AA-U; BK777. "Alexander's Rag Time Crew". Allan Alexander DFC flew 30 Ops.

Lancaster III, JN-M; NE181. "The Captains Fancy". The only 75(NZ) Sqn aircraft to fly 100+ Ops.

Lincoln I, AA-A: RF389. 75(NZ) Sqn only received three Lincolns at Spilsby before VJ Day.

Mosquito, Y-YC. Sold for scrap in 1953, it is now being restored at Ferrymead in Christchurch.

Vampire FB5, NZ 5767. The Squadron operated many of these aircraft from 1952 until 1971.

Canberra B2, WK102. One of eight loaned from the RAF and operated from Tengah 1958-62.

Skyhawk A4-K, NZ6205. The last Skyhawk to fly in RNZAF service after disbandment in 2001.
